It's been another busy month with lots of activity.

Firstly, what can I say except a massive thanks to all of you who completed our Parish Survey.

Out of a total of 520 households we received 212 completed surveys which is a fantastic result and way beyond what we expected and hoped for. You have given us a wealth of data and opinions which we need to carefully digest and analyse. Throughout the survey we were keen to give you as much opportunity to provide additional comments and these too are providing invaluable insights into the issues that matter to you.

Not surprisingly there are commonalities on a whole range of issues but also divergences of opinion. Some of the issues that you raise fall outside of the scope of the Neighbourhood Plan however these must not be lost; for example a whole range of comments on recreation and the Brodie Fields will be passed to the

trustees. Similarly areas that are the responsibility of the Parish Council will also be forwarded to them.

The Steering Group have started the process of reviewing what you have told us so that we can share this with you. From a data protection perspective it is important that all comments are anonymous and cannot be attributed back to you. The vast majority fall within this category however where you have provided commentary that can be attributed these will not be reported – so rest assured.

Our plans for feedback are still being formulated but we have booked the Millennium Hall for the 11<sup>th</sup> October between 12 noon and 4pm so please do drop by between those times.

Other news on what we have done this month:

The Parish Council have again demonstrated their commitment to the Flore Plan by providing funding for the appointment of specialist planning consultants to help us – Kirkwells – who some of you will remember came and gave a talk to us in the Millennium Hall on a wet Monday evening in January. They are supporting a number of Parishes across the country including Weedon. Their appointment is very welcomed.

We also contacted the various groups and societies in the village offering to come and talk about the Plan, what's involved and to listen to what they have to say? There are a lot of them however if for some reason a group that you belong to has not been contacted and you would like us to

come and talk to you then please do let me or one of Steering Group know.

Finally I would also like to welcome Duncan Shepherd as our latest recruit to the Steering Group.

On behalf of the group we look forward to seeing you on the 11<sup>th</sup> October.
